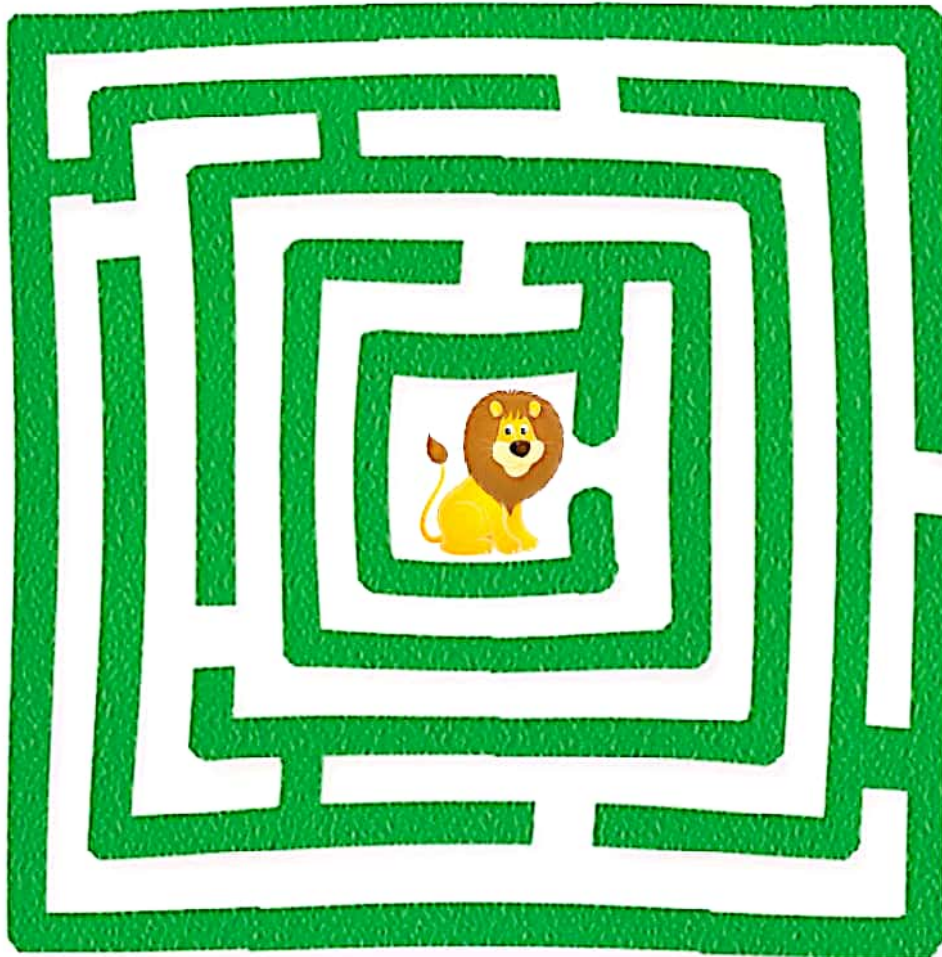

**Describing Words**

Describing words are called **adjectives**. They describe or tell more about nouns. They describe persons, places, animals and things.

**E.g.** An old house.

Here house is the noun that is described by 'old'. So 'old' is the describing word.

**E.g.** A tall man.

Here man is the noun described by 'tall'. So 'tall' is the describing word.
